


Another lovely day, bright sun and warm winds – spring was with us today!

We started with a quick trim along the Grove Lane to Sileby Road jitty – the new growth at high level above the fences quickly drops down to make it difficult to pass and creates a dark footpath.



After a brush up we were then off to the main part of the task today – the Sileby Road to Avon Road jitty.

The end of the jitty at Avon Road has been reported to us a few times as being very narrow in places and with lots of the hedge being hawthorn, it is also very prickly too.

After ensuring that there were no birds nesting this early in spring, we made a start on cutting back the hedge to as close to the fence line as possible. Although this was going to take a while, we also sent a couple of the team further along to jitty to Sibley Road to cut back other small areas of hedgerow that was growing fast. We certainly filled those brown bins to the top today - Thanks to **Charnwood Borough Council** and **Serco** for the 6 bins for all our green waste.
