It didn't take long before the volunteers were up to their usual tricks of diving deep into the undergrowth to retrieve all sorts of rubbish that has been there for some time. No sofa today, but still plenty to put into the trolley for collection by Charnwood Borough Council later.

All cans were taken to the Big Red Bin for the Helipads for Hospital appeal and the bottles cleaned for the recycling bin.
